Leverage digital, interactive video instruction to deliver an individualized and engaging learning experience for each student.

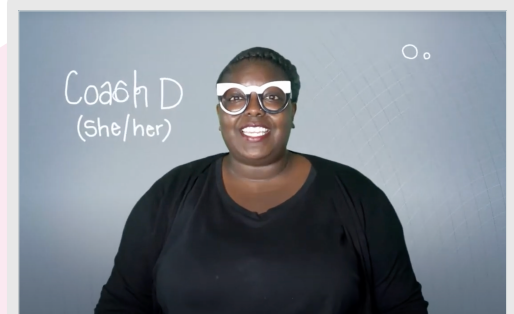

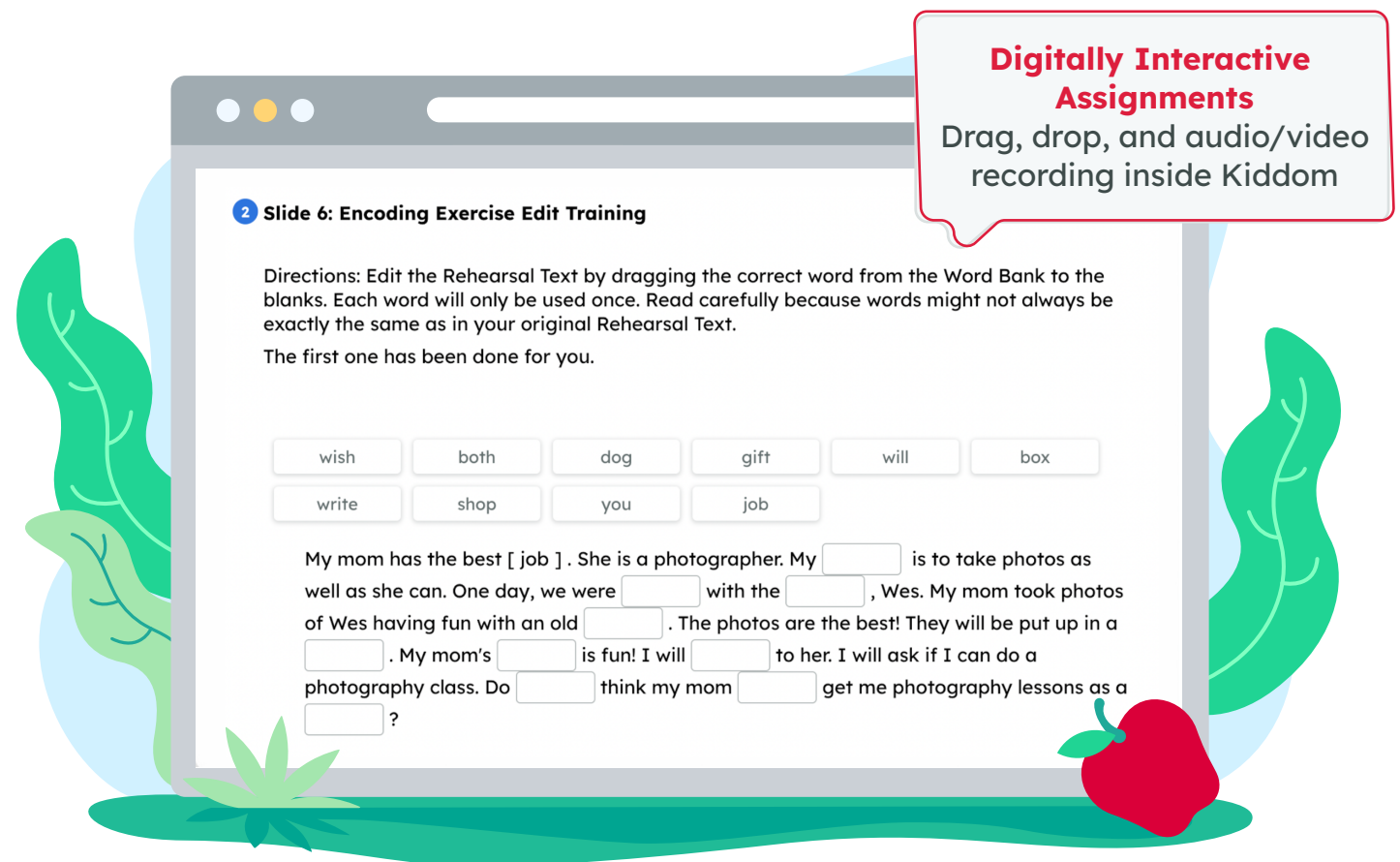


Science of Reading, Phase Theory, and Big 5 Reading

Focusing on 7 of the 12 microphases (starting with Late-Partial Alphabetic) Unlock Phonics is grounded in the Science of Reading and designed based on Dr. Linnea Ehri's phase theory. Teachers can use assessment data to monitor student progress and place students in the correct microphase.
